✠ IN THE LORD'S HOUSE TODAY ✠

✠ THE WORD FOR TODAY ✠

ANXIOUS BONDAGE vs. CONFIDENT TRUST

"You cannot serve God and money" (Matt. 6:24-34), for they require two contrary forms of service. Worry is the worship given to the false god of mammon, an unbelieving anxiousness and focus on the things of this world. Faith is the worship of the true God, a confident trust that He is a loving Father who will care for all of our needs in both body and soul. The widow of Zarephath served God – that is, she believed the word of the Lord spoken by Elijah that the bin of flour would not be used up nor would the jar of oil run dry (1 Kings 17:8-16). He who feeds the birds and clothes the flowers will certainly provide for our daily needs. For He has already provided for our eternal needs, clothing us with Christ's righteousness in Baptism and feeding us His body and blood for our forgiveness. With such confidence we are liberated from worry and freed to do good with our material resources, especially to those who are of the household of faith (Gal. 5:25-6:10).

✠ THE MUSIC FOR TODAY ✠

THE HYMN OF THE DAY FOR TODAY, What God Ordains is Always Good (LSB 760), was a combined effort by Samuel Rodigast (text) and Severus Gastorius (tune). Rodigast, the son of a German Lutheran pastor, was on the philosophical faculty of the Greyfriars Gymnasium in Berlin. The text was written to comfort Severus Gastorius upon a serious illness. Gastorius was cantor of Jena, Germany. The hymn first appeared in print in 1681 and is noted to be a favorite of the choir school Gastorius taught. Johann Sebastian Bach used the tune *WAS GOTT TUT* in seven of his cantatas.

✠ PREPARING FOR WORSHIP ✠

- *PREPARE* to receive the Lord's Supper by reviewing "Christian Questions and Their Answers" beginning on 329 in the front part of *Lutheran Service Book*.
- *REFLECT* on Psalm 146 in the front part of *Lutheran Service Book*.
- *PONDER* today's Hymn of the Day, *LSB 760*, "What God Ordains is Always Good"

HOLY COMMUNION is celebrated at each Sunday morning Divine Service, with both chalice and individual cup offered. Members of congregations of The Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod may partake of the Sacrament trusting that in this Holy Meal the Lord Jesus Christ is present and gives His Body and Blood for our forgiveness, life, and salvation. Guests are asked to speak with the pastor prior to communing. Those who have a health concern with the alcohol in the cup are asked to speak with the pastor. If you are taking Communion, please fill out the attendance card by marking an "X" in the box by the names of those communing, and hand the card to an usher as you go to the Lord's Table.

ST. MICHAEL AND ALL ANGELS (September 27, 2020)

Old Testament: **Daniel 12:1-3** – The cosmic battle between God's faithful and those who reject Him.
Psalm: **Psalm 91** – "He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways."
Epistle: **Revelation 12:7-12** – War between God's angel armies and the forces of the devil.
Holy Gospel: **Matthew 18:1-10** – In the conflict between God's kingdom and the forces of darkness, God's people receive His kingdom as little children.
