#### **№ IN THE LORD'S HOUSE TODAY**

WELCOME! We are happy that you are worshipping with us. As Psalm 122:1 says, "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord!'" Here in the Lord's House our Lord Jesus Christ is truly present in His Word and Sacrament to give us His gifts of forgiveness, life, and salvation. ### **▼ THE WORD FOR TODAY ▼**

#### **WORD ALONE**

The Sower sows the seed of His Word (Luke 8:4–15). This Word is living and powerful (Heb. 4:9–13) to conceive new life in those who hear it. But the planting of Christ is attacked by the devil, the world, and the flesh. Satan snatches the Word away from hard hearts. The riches and pleasures of this life choke off faith. Shallow and emotional belief withers in time of temptation and trouble. But see how Christ bears this attack for us! Christ's cross was planted in the hard and rocky soil of Golgotha. A crown of thorns was placed upon His head. Satan and His demons hellishly hounded and devoured Him. Yet, through His dying and rising again, He destroyed these enemies of ours. Jesus is Himself the Seed which fell to the ground and died in order that it might sprout forth to new life and produce much grain. In Him, the weak are strong (2 Cor. 11:19–12:9). He is the Word of the Father which does not return void (Is. 55:10–13) but yields a harvest hundredfold.

### \* THE MUSIC FOR TODAY \*

By Scripture Alone. From today's Gospel reading of the Parable of the Sower we learn how important it is to be well fed – well fed in the Word of God, so that we might grow in good soil and yield much fruit. All our hymns today focus on this idea, the idea of being in the Word. From Martin Luther's Reformation hymn, Lord, Keep Us Steadfast In Your Word, to Martin Franzmann's twentieth century hymn, Thy Strong Word, we are constantly reminded of our vocation as God's children. The first four stanzas of Thy Strong Word retell salvation's story, tracing history from creation to God's redeeming sacrifice on the cross. The final two stanzas are our response, including a prayer that God would "give us lips to sing Thy glory, tongues thy mercy to proclaim."

### **▼ PREPARING FOR WORSHIP ▼**

- *PREPARE* to receive the Lord's Supper by reviewing "Christian Questions and Their Answers" beginning on 329 in the front part of *Lutheran Service Book*.
- REFLECT on Psalm 84 in the front part of Lutheran Service Book.
- PONDER today's Hymn of the Day, LSB 823, "May God Bestow on Us His Grace"

HOLY COMMUNION is celebrated at each Sunday morning Divine Service, with both chalice and individual cup offered. Members of congregations of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod may partake of the Sacrament trusting that in this Holy Meal the Lord Jesus Christ is present and gives His Body and Blood for our forgiveness, life, and salvation. Guests are asked to speak with the pastor prior to communing. Those who have a health concern with the alcohol in the cup are asked to speak with the pastor. If you are taking Communion, please fill out the attendance card by marking an "X" in the box by the names of those communing, and hand the card to an usher as you go to the Lord's Table.

Psalm: Psalm 146 - "I will praise the LORD as long as I live; I will sing praises to my God while

I have my being."

Epistle: **1 Corinthians 13:1-13** – The greatest of these is love – love in the Christian life. Holy Gospel: **Luke 18:31-43** – Jesus heals the blind man – that we may see Him on His way to

Jerusalem.

STEWARDSHIP BLURB FOR SUNDAY, February 12: Luke 8:11 - "The seed is the word of God." It all starts with the Word. "In the beginning ... the Word was with God" (John 1:1). "He saved us by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit" (Titus 3:5). "The word of our God will stand forever" (Is. 40:8). We never outgrow our need to hear the Word of God. We never achieve such greatness that we don't need the blessings of God's Word. Rather, the Christian life is one of always striving to conform our lives to God's Word by living out the truth of our Baptism: that we are God's children by the power of his Word.
