THE LORD COMES ON THE LAST DAY

The day on which our Lord returns will be a "great and awesome day" (Mal. 4:5). For He will come in a cloud with great power and glory. To the wicked and the proud, it will be a Day of judgment that will "set them ablaze" (Mal. 4:1). The signs preceding this Day will bring them fear and fainting. But to those who believe, who fear the name of the Lord, this Day is one to look forward to and rejoice in: "...straighten up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near" (Luke 21:28). Christ our Redeemer is coming; the Sun of Righteousness will bring healing in His wings. Let us, then, give attention to the words of the Lord, which do not pass away. Let us "through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures" (Rom. 15:4) be strengthened in our hope by the Holy Spirit and watch diligently for Jesus' coming. Then, by God's grace, we shall escape all these things that will come to pass and stand before the Son of Man.

* THE MUSIC FOR TODAY *

LO! HE COMES WITH CLOUDS DESCENDING (LSB 336)

Charles Wesley saw that, according to Luther, music teaches the faith and imprints it strongly upon the heart. So he did in this hymn. The tune does what the text declares. As the music descends so the text confesses "...with clouds descending." As the congregation and musicians swell so we sing "Swell the triumph of His train, Alleluia...." The hymn primarily pictures through song the words of Revelation 1:7: "Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him, and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen." Some slight editing has taken place from Wesley's original which shows theological difference between the Methodists and Lutherans, "once for favored sinners slain," now reads "Once for every sinner slain." NEW ADVENT BANNERS AND WHAT THEY MEAN: Our new blue banners point to Jesus as the coming King. The Root of Jesse banner, with a live shoot arising from the root, comes from Isaiah 11:10, "In that day the root of Jesse, who shall stand as a signal for the peoples – of him shall the nations inquire, and his resting place shall be glorious." Jesus descended from the line of Jesse and his son, David. In the second banner the door is partially open to reveal the Chi Rho (XP) symbol with a crown for the coming King. Jesus said, "I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture" (John 10:9). The Chi Rho symbol is taken from the first two letters of the Greek word "Christos" - XPI Σ TO Σ .
