### **THE EASTER GOSPEL - John 20:1-18**

**Pastor:** After Jesus rose early on Sunday, Mary stood outside, facing the grave and crying. As she cried, she looked into the grave and saw two angels in white clothes, sitting where the body of Jesus had been laying. They asked her:

**Men:** **Woman, why are you crying?**

**Women:** **They have taken my Lord away and I don't know where they have laid him.**

**Pastor:** As she said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but

she didn't know it was Jesus.

**Men: Woman, why are you crying? For whom are you looking?**

**Women: Sir, if you have carried him away tell me where you have laid him, and I will take him away.**

Pastor: Jesus said to her:

**Men: Mary!**

Pastor: She turned and said to Him in the Aramaic language.

**Women: My Master!**

Pastor: Jesus told her:

**Men: Do not hold on to me because I have not yet returned to my father, but go to my brothers and tell them I am going up to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.**

Pastor: Mary from Magdala went up to the Disciples who had been with Him, and who now were mourning and crying, and she told them:

**Women: I have seen the Lord and he has said these things to me!**

Pastor: This is the Easter Gospel of our Lord.
