## Waiting and Looking

In his Children's book, "Oh, the places You'll Go," Dr. Suess invites his readers into a life of excitement and wonder. There are so many wonderful things to do, people to see and places to go! The book ends with a declaration "Kid, you'll move mountains!" But Dr. Suess isn't naïve. He lets the character know that sometimes things won't go so well in life. You might get in a slump and there are times when things won't go as you planned. In particular, Dr. Suess cautions against a most useless place: the waiting place. People are "just waiting for a train to go, or a bus to come, or the rain to go, or the phone to ring or the snow to snow," etc. The point he makes is that people aren't getting after it. They could be out there accomplishing challenges and overcoming obstacles, but instead, they are just waiting for things to happen.

As we think about our lives as Christians, we are clearly warned against this side of waiting, especially as we end one year and start another. Recently, in 2 Thessalonians, we were warned against "idleness," against waiting around and not using the gifts and abilities we have to love and serve others. Waiting in this sense is not a good thing. We are all too familiar with the consequences as a result of waiting. Instead of talking through a problem with a friend right away, you wait, and it festers and slowly grows into a big problem, so much so that you are no longer friends. You wait too long to pay your bills and you end up making late payments that involve additional fees. You know the tires need to be changed, but you wait too long, and now you've got a flat. Even though you feel you're

procrastination helps you work well under pressure, you wait too long to start on a big project and you can't complete it. You wait to get a health problem checked out, and now the damage is permanent. And who suffers? You and your neighbors, those who God has called you to serve. Yes, the waiting place can be very useless indeed!

But there's another aspect to waiting that isn't useless. We just ended the church year and started a new one with the season of advent and Christmas and we are still waiting for Jesus to return. Yes, we are waiting to Epiphany once more, recalling the wisemen. But still it's all past. The manger, the shepherds, the wisemen, all of that is in the history books. However, there are two parts of the Nicene creed that we confess that haven't happened yet. "And he will come again in glory to judge both the living and the dead, whose kingdom shall have no end..." And I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come." With living and expectant hope in our Lord Jesus... we wait and look for these things! The Psalmist declares in Psalm 130 I wait for the LORD, my soul waits, and in his word I hope; my soul waits for the Lord more than watchmen for the morning, more than watchmen for the morning. We wait for our Lord Jesus and in his word, we hope and cling to his promises. And someday, it will be as the Christmas hymn, Once in Royal David's City, concludes: "Not in that poor, lowly stable With the oxen standing by Shall we see Him, but in heaven, Set at God's right hand on high. Then like stars His children, crowned, All in white, His praise will sound!"



From the Finance Board.....

In December to date, \$15,664.12 has been received for the Budget. Our current budget position is shown in the table below. This information is also provided bi-weekly in the bulletin.

The amount received for the budget in 2022 (year to date) is approximately 13% higher than the amount received at the same time in 2021. Immanuel members continue to support the Daycare, Daycare Playground, Local Missions (InAsMuch), Youth and Sanctuary Renovations. Many members purchased poinsettias which will beautify the Sanctuary at Christmas!
