

IMMANUEL LUTHERAN SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM – CHARGE POLICY

Immanuel Lutheran School serves nutritious lunches. All meals, extra milks, extra entrees, and extra sides should be prepaid. A monthly menu is provided for each student.

It is strongly encouraged that parents/guardians make meal payments in advance. If you are unable to pay for school meals due to your economic situation, please contact the school office.

Children from families whose income is at or below the government guidelines are eligible for either free or reduced price meals. To apply, an application must be completed, signed, and returned to the school office for processing. These application forms may be picked up from the school office.

We strongly discourage meal charges, but we understand that an occasional emergency makes it necessary.

- No soda is to be brought to school for lunch.
- Parents are not to send/bring fast food lunches into the cafeteria for their children.
- Lunch bills must be kept current. Every Friday all parents/guardians are sent reminders. Up to \$ 20.00 may be charged. Prompt payment is expected when students account is above \$ 20.00 in charges.
- All meals must be served with milk. Juice is not a substitute; the student will be charged. Students allergic to milk may substitute juice only with a doctor's note.
- Student lunches are not allowed to be heated in the microwave.
