#### THE START OF SCHOOL

Are you ready? The beginning of school is fast approaching! August 23rd will be the first day of school starting at 8 a.m. **SHARP!** School will get out at 12 p.m. on the first day of school so there will be no After-care. Before-care will start at 6:30 a.m. and ends at 7:45 a.m. *Any* and *all* elementary students K-5th, that arrive before 7:45 a.m. will be taken to Before-care, (this includes 7:44 a.m.), there *will not* be exceptions unless a parent is with them until 7:45 a.m.

We ask that parents get your child to school on time! Late students disrupts the classroom.

Some ideas to help do this:

- \* Getting to bed early
- \* Set clothes out the night before
- \* Pack a lunch the night before
- \* Shower the night before instead of the morning
- \* Set more then one alarm...parents should do this as well
- \* Have backpack packed and ready to go the night before



# LETS TALK DROP OFF AND PICK UP OF STUDENTS

Parents may drop their student off in the mornings at the front door in the circle drive but there is absolutely no parking in the driveway. If you would like to bring your student in, you <u>MUST</u> park in the parking lot and bring them in. K-5 students will need to go to Before Care if dropped off before 7:45 a.m. because our teachers are in devotion at that time. Afternoon pick ups for k-5 grade school will be in the driveway, parents will get in line and the teachers will bring your students out.
