School News

Immanuel Preschool

Our 3's program will be offering two different sessions again next year and they are filling up. As of today, we have eight spots remaining. The 4's program will have both a morning and afternoon class as part of the Voluntary Preschool Program with



the morning class overflowing. We are moving to a waiting list for the morning class and looking at options for expanding our extended care to accommodate these children into the afternoon class while providing the all-day coverage they need. We have about 8 spaces remaining to fill the program at 36 children. If you have

an interest or know of someone looking for a program, please let them know to reach out to us soon if they want a spot. Our classrooms are busy with children who love to learn. Topics that we have been covering include the stories of Zacchaeus, Jesus Healing the 10 Lepers, and Jesus healing various people. Through word and song, the stories of the bible are forever placed in the children's hearts and minds. They can see how these stories then relate to their lives as they work and play with others. It is through these songs and stories that the children share the love of Jesus with their parents, grandparents, and friends. This is yet another way in which we are spreading the Gospel.

The children were able to have a guest visit them this month as learned how important it is to clean their teeth. They were able to practice brushing, look at x-rays, and learn how to floss between their teeth. Thanks to Cindy Wolf from Black Hawk County Public Health for taking the time to engage with our children in this activity.



Play is an important part of a child's early development, and it helps their young brains develop. It also helps their language and communication skills to mature. Our classrooms are filled with fun and exciting activities in which fosters play and learning. We ask that you continue to pray for our program and ask God to send us the children who need us.
