



Sunday School Memory Work

As you may or may not know, ILC has a long history of including memorization work in our curriculum. This work provides students a progression of knowledge and skills to be successful throughout elementary and in to their confirmation work and beyond.

The Education Committee collaborated and agreed that the previous expectations of memorized Bible verses, is not necessary, however the children will be expected to be able to look up their grade level Bible verses and read them. Third grade students and higher will need to bring their bibles provided by the church with them each Sunday. Doing so, will allow each student to read from a common version and highlight verses discussed throughout the year.

We believe partnering with families for this work is a benefit to all involved as we learn and grow in Christ together. You can find a complete list of work by grade level on the second page of this letter. Children can recite their required memorization to their classroom teacher, Angie Frink or Leslie Perrigo whenever he/she feels ready. Teachers will also be working with children on required memorization in the classroom but know that additional work at home may be needed.
