Masks and Precautions

Masks will be optional for outside events involving only youth (there may be volunteer opportunities that masks will be required even though we are outside). I will try to keep events outside as much as possible. Masks are mandatory when events are held inside. If we are maintaining social distancing masks will be optional inside (this will be determined by Youth Director and/or chaperones). All spaces the youth come in contact with will be thoroughly cleaned. Food will be served by a chaperone wearing gloves and a mask, or in individual packages. I ask for you to encourage your youth to be respectful of the wishes of the church. There are people around us (myself included) who have compromised immune systems. IMPORTANT NEW INFORMATION BELOW

Chaperones

- All events need 2 chaperones (not including the Youth Director)
 - Why? The church's Sexual Misconduct Prevention Procedures states: "We require a minimum of two, non-related adults to be present with children at all times." My thinking is this, if we only have 2 chaperones (one person plus myself) and there is an emergency where one of us has to leave, then all the student's parents will have to be contacted and the event will have to end early. But by having 3 chaperones, if there is an emergency where one has to leave we can still continue on with the event and avoid a headache. These procedures are put in place to keep everyone safe, and that is very important. Please help us out by chaperoning and do not ask me to be lenient on this rule. You do not do your job carelessly, please do not ask me to do mine carelessly.

• Chaperone Incentives

- Every time a parent chaperones, their child(ren)'s name(s) will be put in a basket for a drawing. These drawings will be done at random times and will not be made known prior to the event in which they take place. Additionally, for a youth to be eligible to win the drawing they must have attended three events since the last drawing.
 - Youth are allowed only two parents to count towards the drawing. This means that if a youth's parents are divorced and both are remarried, they will only get their name in the drawing when a specified two volunteer. Of course, all of them may volunteer, it just won't count towards the drawing. In the same way, if a youth is from a single parent household they can designate a grandparent, aunt, friend, etc. to be their second "parent" and get their name in the drawing when that person volunteers. This is to try to keep things fair. This is not to be controversial, it is simply a way to encourage people to volunteer!

New Together Time Structure

It is important that we foster to both Jr. and Sr. High Youth. It has come to my attention that it would be beneficial to have separate Together Times (TT). So as it stands, Jr. High TT will be from 5:30-7:30pm and Sr. High TT will be from 7-9pm. Sr. High are welcome to join at 5:30 pm if they wish, but I ask that all Jr. High be picked up at 7:30 pm.

• Praise and Worship-during the 30 minute overlap we will be having a praise and worship time. This will consist of offering, worship songs, and a devotion.

Meals

• Concerning meals for TT, Advent, and Lent- I am asking families (or congregation members) to <u>donate</u> the meals. I would like the meals to be donated because I think the money we bring in for LYF can be used for events and activities that have a more valuable impact on the youth and congregation. Additionally, since our goal is to have the meals donated I will not be asking for \$3 each week, instead I ask you encourage your youth to bring an offering for Praise and Worship.

We will be studying the differences between Christian denominations at 9:45 am, Sundays in the Youth Room. Please encourage your youth to join!
