NICE/GRENOBLE/LYON

FRIDAY, NOV 4

Depart Nice and drive along the Route of Napoleon to Grenoble. Continue past the orchards of the Rhone Valley to Lyon on the bank of the River Rhone. Situated in the heart of Burgundy, Lyon is a vibrant city with many fine restaurants and is renowned as the home of French gastronomy. Your city tour includes a visit to the Basilique de Notre Dame De Fourviere and the old town with its medieval churches and Renaissance houses. **(B,D)**

SATURDAY, NOV 5

Drive northwest through the heart of the Loire Valley, passing lush vineyards and elegant chateaux. Overnight in the Tours area. **(B,D)**

Drive along the meandering River Cher to the beautiful 16th-century Chateau de Chenonceaux. Enjoy a tour through the handsome rooms known to Catherine de Medici and view the magnificent tapestries and formal gardens. Next is the imposing fortress-castle Chateau d' Amboise, royal residence of Charles VIII. Overnight in the Tours area. **(B,D)**

**LOIRE VALLEY/SAUMUR/BRITTANY/
MONT ST. MICHEL AREA**

MONDAY, NOV 7

Enjoy a scenic drive through Saumur, know for its cavalry school and sparkling wine, and then across the rugged countryside of Brittany to Mont St. Michel on the western edge of Normandy. Perched on a rocky island in the Gulf of Saint Malo, the town's 15th century gabled houses and stalls lead skyward to the massive Abbey. Its remarkable fortifications were attacked many times during the Hundred Years War, but never conquered. Overnight in Mont St. Michel area. **(B,D)**

**MONT ST. MICHEL/BAYEUX/
NORMANDY/CAEN**

TUESDAY, NOV 8

Morning walking tour of the town and Abbey at Mont St. Michel. Then proceed to Bayeux, a lovely city filled with gracious mansions. Here you will view the 11th

century *Tapestry of Queen Matilda* depicting the entire story of William The Conqueror's invasion of England in 1066. Continue to Normandy to see Omaha Beach, where Allied troops stormed ashore to launch the D-Day invasion. See the American Military Cemetery and Monument. **(B,D)**

CAEN/ROUEN/PARIS

WEDNESDAY, NOV 9

Depart Caen for historic Rouen. Leisure time to see the Cathedral of Notre Dame and stroll along the cobbled Rue du Gros-Horloge leading to Place du Vieux-Marche, the square where Joan of Arc was burned at the stake in 1431. This afternoon continue to Paris, "City of Light." **(B)**

PARIS

THURSDAY, NOV 10

Your morning tour of Paris will include many of the famous landmarks recognized throughout the world such as the Opera House, the Madeleine Church, the Place de la Concorde, the Champs Elysees, Napoleon's great Arc de Triomphe, Les Invalides, the Military Academy and the Eiffel Tower. Visit the impressive Notre Dame Cathedral. Afternoon at leisure. **(B)**
