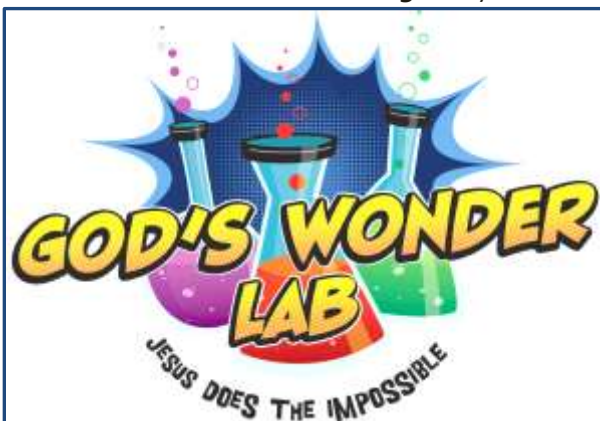
Family Olympics 2021
