

UPDATE ON REDEEMING LIFE OUTREACH MINISTRIES (RLOM) – New maternity home in East Dundee

Supporting RLOM began way back in May at the Women's Tea – the attendees gave offerings to help with the building of a home that would provide housing for unwed moms and their infants. The tea offerings were followed by donations from Immanuel members which later in the summer were followed by a door offering. All offerings combined were \$1512.61.

Our support for RLOM was added to offerings collected through door offerings from Good Shepherd, Frankfort and Trinity, Tinley Park totaling \$1132.

Through a million-dollar matching grant from LCMS, we received \$1700.

In early October, a check for \$4344.61 was sent to Redeeming Life Outreach Ministries. The new maternity home is nearly ready for its grand opening – occupants are being selected and the house is being decorated and furnishings are being purchased. Because of your generosity and our sister congregations, a dining room set and accompanying furniture will be awaiting the occupants. The dining room, of course, will be a place for meals but will also provide a place for daily gatherings, conversations and opportunities for fellowship.

News of the official opening will be shared soon – thank you so much for supporting this project, sharing Christ's love and bringing hope to moms and babies in Northern Illinois.

LWML NEWS: Read how your mite offerings are working in lands far away and right here in our own back yard – thank you for your support and showing the love of Jesus around the world.

NATIONAL LWML GRANT - 2023-2025 Water and the Word - Evangelical Lutheran Church in Kenya - \$80,000

Students in schools and orphanages sponsored by the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Kenya (ELCK) lack clean water and regular access to pastoral care. Water and the Word, based in Thermopolis, Wyoming works with the ELCK to improve water systems for the schools. After evaluating a school's needs, Water and the Word installs water harvesting equipment (rain gutters and tanks), locally sourced filters, hand wash stations, and clean water storage systems. Students and staff are taught about personal

hygiene, handwashing, and the importance of drinking only clean water. After installation, an ELCK pastor (trained in water equipment) visits the schools every 3-4 months to ensure that the water system is working, visits with the children, and provides needed pastoral care. This grant will provide clean water and cover travel expenses for pastoral care to students in 12 additional schools and orphanages in Kenya.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS DISTRICT LWML GRANT 2022-2024

Trinity Lutheran Church and School of Tinley Park: \$10,668.90

Trinity Lutheran School is remodeling a room to be a "maker space" with building and crafting material storage along the walls. They will purchase new technological learning materials and open up the room so students can collaborate together and explore the world God created.


