

IMMANUEL WORSHIP COORDINATOR ROLE

Interested in growing in your service journey at Immanuel? We have the opportunity for you! The Board of Elders is creating a new role to support our weekly worship process – the role of Worship Coordinator. This opportunity is available to all. What is the role?

The worship coordinator will assist with many of the key functions it takes to support each service. Key elements of the role:

• Manage lights & thermostats

- Turn on & off lobby TV
- Turn on & check sound board
- Coordinate lighting & extinguishing of altar candles
- Ring the bell at the start of service
- Take attendance & log in the journal (including # of communicants on communion Sundays)
- Ring bell during Lord's prayer
- Provide oversight for special conditions
 snow in parking lot (clear from entrance, salt as necessary)
- Bring offerings to the altar on noncommunion Sundays
- Put away offerings in basement safe
- Usher during communion

This is a great way to get more involved in service at Immanuel. The plan is to create a monthly schedule of those serving this role for each service. If one is unable to attend on their planned service we would request contacting an Elder in advance.

FROM THE BOARD OF STEWARDSHIP

Lenten Stewardship Project

LWR Personal Care Kits – Below is the information we provided last month regarding this ongoing project. We will continue to accept donations in the lobby of any of the items at any time through 3/17 — the schedule is a suggested sequence.

Lent may be a time of reflection, but it need not be one of inaction. This Lent, the board of stewardship is encouraging the congregation to put God's love in action by making Lutheran World Relief Personal Care Kits. Across the globe, families have been suffering from compounding crises such as war, violence, natural disasters, disease and extreme weather. We want to announce to the world that Christ makes a new season possible: a Season of Hope. We're excited to engage in this project as a church family during our Lenten journey this year.

Each week, a different item will be collected in the lobby.

- Week 1 (2/17-18): Bars of Soap (2-3 bars, 4 to 5 oz., any brand, in original wrapping)
- Week 2 (2/24-25): Bath Towels (light-weight, maximum 52"x27", dark color recommended)
- Week 3 (3/2-3): Toothbrushes (adult size, in original packaging)
- Week 4 (3/9-10): Combs
- Week 5 (3/16-17): Nail Clippers (metal, attached file optional)

A handout listing the above schedule and items will also be available in the lobby.

We welcome any donations you can provide. The board of stewardship will add to what is collected to ensure we have enough for each personal care kit. We plan to assemble the kits in April, and will announce the date and time so that others can join us in this activity if they wish!
