### NATIONAL LWML GRANT - 2023-2025 Mobile Kitchen-2023-2025 Mission Grant — \$85,000

Forged by Fire Services strives to actively make known the love of Jesus Christ through its actions and words by providing warm meals, bottled water, and spiritual care to people in times of need following a disaster or economic downturn. They pray with those in need and offer resources such as devotionals and Bibles. This grant will allow the purchase of a mobile, self-contained kitchen trailer unit to provide meals in communities affected by disaster. Over 130,000 meals have been served in the Gulf Coast region. The mobile kitchen will benefit

smaller communities in need that are often overlooked by larger organizations. When serving, Forged by Fire Services strives to connect local LCMS congregations within the communities and shares the mercy and grace of Christ, one plate of food at a time.

Interested in growing in your service journey at Immanuel? We have the opportunity for you! The Board of Elders is creating a new role to support our weekly worship process — the role of Worship Coordinator. This opportunity is available to all. What is the role?

The worship coordinator will assist with many of the key functions it takes to support each service. Key elements of the role:

- Manage lights & thermostats
- Turn on & off lobby TV
- Turn on & check sound board
- Coordinate lighting & extinguishing of altar candles
- Ring the bell at the start of service
- Take attendance & log in the journal (including # of communicants on communion Sundays)
- · Ring bell during Lord's prayer
- Provide oversight for special conditions
   snow in parking lot (clear from entrance, salt as necessary)
- Bring offerings to the altar on noncommunion Sundays
- Put away offerings in basement safe
- Usher during communion

This is a great way to get more involved in service at Immanuel. The plan is to create a monthly schedule of those serving this role for each service. If one is unable to attend on their planned service we would request contacting an Elder in advance.


