Fishers4Christ: Our 6th - 8th grade youth group meets on Sunday mornings at 9:15 in the youth room from September through May for Bible Study. This is in combination with our Teens In Christ. We also have fun activities throughout the year such as game nights, lock-ins, servant events, and mission trips. Group size will vary, and activities may be combined with the Teens In Christ based on the number of students we have.

Teens In Christ (TICs): Our Teens In Christ is a youth group for high school students (9th – 12th grades) who are interested in growing in faith. They have chosen Psalms 27:1 as their mission, to be the light of Christ. The majority of our activities are during the school year (Sep – May) and coincide with the Sunday School and Midweek class times. Sunday mornings (9:15 – 10:15 am) is Youth Bible study. Wednesday evenings is TIC Time (6:30 – 7:30 pm). TIC Time is a student-led devotion and activity hour with an emphasis on building relationships with peers. Throughout the year many other activities are planned by the youth and counselors. Activities have included, but are not limited to lock-ins, movie nights, game nights, bowling, kickball tournaments, servant events and mission projects. During the year youth also lead special events such as the Thanksgiving Eve Worship Service, Easter Sunday Breakfast and Egg Hunt. We participate in the LCMS Regional Youth Gathering (yearly) and the National Youth Gathering (every three years).

Besides all the fun, these programs are flexible and allow us to incorporate other aspects of Christian living, including Mission trips, volunteer events, Every Kid to Camp Youth Leaders, helping younger kids/Sunday School with activities, Vacation Bible School leader opportunities, and Worship Services.
