
Application of God's Word

Creamed Chipped Beef on Toast Ingredients

- 2 tablespoons butter
- •2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- •1 ½ cups warm milk
- •1 (8 ounce) jar dried beef, chopped
- 1 pinch cayenne pepper
- ·Bread, toasted



Directions

1.Melt butter in a medium saucepan over low heat. Add flour and whisk until smooth. Add milk a little at a time, whisking well after each addition. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat and cook, stirring, until thickened.
2.Stir in beef and cayenne; cook until warmed through. Serve over toast.



Mom's Soft Raisin Cookies

Ingredients

- •1 cup water
- •2 cups raisins
- •1 cup shortening
- •1-3/4 cups sugar
- 2 large eggs
- ·1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- •3-1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- •1 teaspoon baking powder
- ·1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- •1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- *1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- *1/2 cup chopped walnuts

Directions


- Combine water and raisins in a small saucepan; bring to a boil. Cook for 3 minutes; remove from the heat and let cool (do not drain).
- Preheat oven to 350°. In a large bowl, cream shortening and sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in eggs and vanilla. Combine flour, baking powder, baking soda, salt and spices; gradually add to creamed mixture and mix well. Stir in nuts and raisins.
- Drop by teaspoonfuls 2 in. apart onto greased baking sheets. Bake 12-14 minutes or until golden brown. Remove to wire racks to cool.


Q: How long have you been members of Fish Lake Immanuel Lutheran Church?
