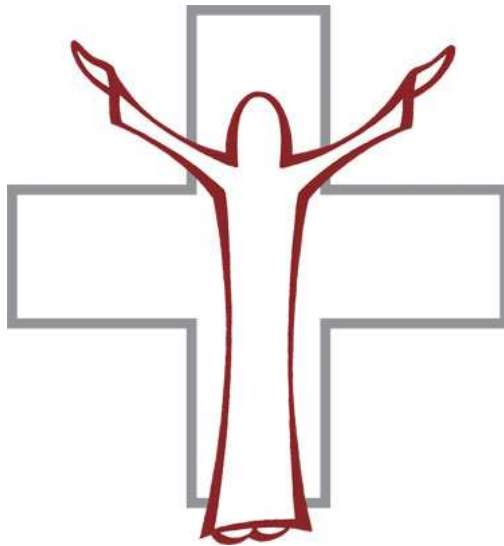

P Taught by our Lord and trusting in His promises, we are bold to pray:

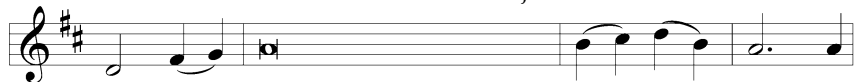

Committal Service: St. Paul's/Immanuel Lutheran Cemetery

The committal at the grave side is viewed as the continuation of the funeral service where we lay at rest the remains of our fellow saint in Christ for entombment. Here we make the proclamation of the sure hope belonging to those who die in Christ that "we look to the Resurrection of the Body and Life Everlasting" on the Last Day when the tombs will be burst open and the dead in Christ will be raised, just as Jesus has been raised from the dead. As this is the primary hope of the Christian faith, whenever possible, everyone is encouraged to attend the Committal. As a continuation of the service, whenever possible the Benediction will be spoken at the Committal. (If weather or other limiting factors do not permit, the Committal portion of the funeral service may be performed in the sanctuary.)
