## **PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION**

P: “Blessed are they whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.

**C: Blessed are they whose sin the Lord does not count against them and in whose spirit is no deceit.**

P: I said, “I will confess my transgressions to the Lord”

**C: And You forgave the guilt of my sin.”** [Psalms 32:1-2, 5]

P: Let us confess our sins in before God and His Church.

**C: Gracious Lord, I confess that I have sinned against You in thought, word and deed.**

P: I have sinned against You by what I have done and by what I have left undone.

**C: I try to do right; but I fall into temptation. I know the difference between right and wrong and still I fail.** [Rom 7]

P: Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion blot out my transgressions. Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. [Ps 51:1-2]

**C: Forgive me, renew and restore me by Your grace and through the person and work of Jesus my Savior and Great High Priest.**

P: Almighty God, our gracious heavenly Father, has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light. He has rescued you from the dominion of darkness and brought you into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. [Col 1:12-14] In the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of Father, and the ☩ Son and the Holy Spirit.

**C: Amen.**

## **THE CONSECRATION**

P: Holy, mighty and merciful Lord, heaven and earth are full of Your glory.

**C: In great love You sent Jesus Your Son to be our Great High Priest**

P: To offer Himself as the atonement for our sins.

**C: To shed His blood on the cross and die for us.**

P: On the night in which He was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread, gave thanks; broke it and gave it to His disciples, saying:

**C: “Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”**

P: Again after supper, He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them saying:

- C:** "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this in remembrance of me."
- P:** Remembering His death, resurrection and ascension, we await His coming in glory.
- C:** **O Lord of heaven and earth, we give You thanks for the redemption You have prepared for us through Jesus Christ.**
- P:** Send Your Holy Spirit into our hearts that He may nourish our faith and prepare us to remember our Redeemer and receive Him who comes to us in His body and blood.
- C:** **Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven; Give us this day our daily bread; And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; And lead us not into temptation; But deliver us from evil; For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.**

At King of Kings, we welcome at Holy Communion all baptized Christians who believe that Jesus Christ is present in this Sacrament and that forgiveness of sins is given in it. Children who have not yet been instructed to receive Holy Communion and those who are not yet baptized are invited to come forward to receive a blessing.
