PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: If You, O Lord, kept a record of sins,

C: O Lord, who could stand?

P: But with You there is forgiveness;

C: Therefore You are feared. [Ps 130:3-4]

P: Let us confess our sins to our merciful Father.

All: Holy and most merciful God, hear my confession and have mercy on me. I am a sinner. I plead guilty before You O Lord. I have lived as if You did not matter and as if I mattered most. I have not honored Your name as I should. My worship and prayers have faltered. I have not loved You with all my heart, soul and strength. I have not been a good steward of the resources You have entrusted to me. I have resisted sharing Your love with others. There are those whom I have hurt and those whom I have failed to help. My thoughts and desires, words and actions have been corrupted with sin. Forgive my sins, remove my guilt, cleanse my conscience, restore me to Yourself and give me strength to live as Your faithful child.

P: Receive the forgiveness Christ won for you by His Passion, death, and resurrection. By the command of our Lord Jesus Christ I, a called and ordained servant of the Word, forgive you your sins in the Name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.
