## **PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION**

P: After Adam and Eve sinned, God expelled them from the Garden of Eden. God cursed the ground saying,

**C: "Cursed is the ground because of you... By the sweat of your face you shall eat bread, till you return to the ground, for out of it you were taken; for you are dust, and to dust you shall return." [Gen 3:17-19]**

P: We have sinned against God and life is hard.

**C: We have sinned against one another and our lives are difficult and painful.**

P: At times God has given us the bread of adversity to eat.

**C: And the water of affliction to drink. [Isa 30:20]**

P: Nevertheless, God does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities.

**C: For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him. [Ps 103:11-12]**

P: The Bible says, "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." [1 Jn 1:8]

**C: The Bible also says, "If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." [1 Jn 1:9]**

P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

**C: Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean.**

P: We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone.

**C: We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.**

P: We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us.

**C: Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name.**

P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of the Word I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Our God promises, "He who walks righteously and speaks what is right... His bread will be supplied, and water will not fail him." [Isa 33:15-16]

## **THE CONSECRATION**

At King of Kings, we welcome at Holy Communion all baptized Christians who believe that Jesus Christ is present in this Sacrament and that forgiveness of sins is given in it.
