PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: The Lord is in His holy temple; the Lord is on His heavenly throne. He observes the sons of men; His eyes examine them. [Ps 11:4]

C: **"Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" Turn to me and be gracious to me... Look upon my affliction and my distress and take away all my sins.** [Mk 10:47, Ps 25:15-18]

P: We have sinned and done wrong. We have broken Your covenant.

C: **We have not been faithful to You or to one another.**

P: We are sinners. Have mercy on us O God.

C: **Forgive our sins. Redeem us and restore us according to Your grace and mercy.**

P: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ; I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

All: **Amen.**
