CONFESSION & ABSOLUTION

- P: Merciful God and Father, to Whom all hearts are open and no secrets hidden, lead me to true penitence and contrition.
- C: Give me courage to confess my sins before You. I know my guilt. I fear Your righteousness.**
- P: Those sins I did not think shameful to commit... Let me not think shameful to confess.
- C: Employ the pain of my confession to turn me away from the sins to which I am tempted.**
- P: Help me to trust that it is Your love that burns in my heart to refine my soul. Let us confess our sins,
- All: O almighty God, merciful Father, I, a poor, miserable sinner, confess unto You all my sins and iniquities with which I have ever offended You and justly deserved Your temporal and eternal punishment. But I am heartily sorry for them and sincerely repent of them, and I pray You of Your boundless mercy and for the sake of the holy, innocent, bitter sufferings and death of Your beloved Son, Jesus Christ, to be gracious and merciful to me, a poor, sinful being.**
- P: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of God's Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ; I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son ☩ and of the Holy Spirit. Since we confess our sins to a Father who judges each of us impartially, let us live our lives as strangers here in reverent fear. For

we know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that we were redeemed but with the precious blood of Christ. [1 Pet 1:17-19]

C: Amen. Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered. Blessed are those whose sins the Lord does not count against him. [Ps 32:1-2]

THE SERVICE OF HOLY COMMUNION

P: On the night in which He was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread, gave thanks; broke it and gave it to His disciples, saying:

All: "Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

P: Again, after supper, He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them saying:

All: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this in remembrance of me."

P: Remembering His death, resurrection and ascension, we await His coming in glory.

C: O Lord of heaven and earth, we give You thanks for the redemption You have prepared for us through Jesus Christ.

P: Send Your Holy Spirit into our hearts that we may properly remember our Redeemer, truly receive Him who comes to us in His body and blood, and trust in His salvation.

C: Amen.

P: The peace of the Lord be with you always.

C: And also with you. Amen.
