INVOCATION

P: In the name of the Father, and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

P: "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." [Gen 1:1]

C: **"By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible."** [Heb 11:3]

P: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning.

C: **Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made."** [Jn 1:1-3]

P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

C: **Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart: we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment.**

For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.

P: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of God's Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.
