**CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION**

P: The Bible says, "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." [1 John 1:8]

C: **The Bible also says, "If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."** [1 John 1:9]

P: We know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that we were redeemed, but with the precious blood of Christ,

- C:** **He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for our sakes.** [1 Peter 1:18-20]
- P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father. Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone.
- C:** **We have made bad choices. We have not loved You with our whole heart;**
- P: We have chosen to satisfy our own desires. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.
- C:** **We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name.**
- P: If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things? Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? [Romans 8:31-34]
- C:** **It is God who justifies. Who is He that condemns? Christ Jesus, who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.** [Rom 8:33-34]
- P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of the Word I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

## STATEMENT OF FAITH

from Luther's Small Catechism

P: Let us confess our Christian faith.

**C: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.**

P: He has given me my body and soul, eyes, ears, and all my members, my reason and all my senses, and still preserves them.

**C: He defends me against all danger, and guards and protects me from all evil;**

P: All this He does purely out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me;

**C: I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord.**

P: He has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil;

**C: Not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and with His innocent suffering and death;**

P: So that I may be His own, and live under Him in His kingdom, and serve Him.

**C: I believe in the Holy Spirit.**

P: The Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith.

**C: In the same way He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith.**

P: In this Christian church He daily and richly forgives all my sins and the sins of all believers.

**C: He will at the last Day raise up me and all the dead, and give unto me and all believers in Christ eternal life.**

P: This is most certainly true.

**C: Amen.**
