LORD'S PRAYER

PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: Beloved in the Lord! Let us draw near with a true heart and confess our sins unto God, our Father, beseeching Him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness. Our help is in the name of the Lord.

C: "With God, there is forgiveness.

P: Put your hope in the Lord, for with the Lord is unfailing love.

C: With the Lord is full redemption." [Ps 130, 4, 7]

P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

C: Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean.

P: We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone.

C: We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.

P: We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us.

C: Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name.

P: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ; I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen.

THE CONSECRATION

At King of Kings, we welcome at Holy Communion all baptized Christians who believe that Jesus Christ is present in this Sacrament and that forgiveness of sins is given in it. Children who have not yet been instructed to receive Holy Communion and those who are not yet baptized are invited to come forward to receive a blessing. 
