### CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: “The Lord looks down from heaven on the sons of men to see if there are any who understand, any who seek God.

- C:** **All have turned aside, they have together become corrupt; there is no one who does good, not even one.** [Ps 14:2-3]
- P: "Many are the woes of the wicked, but the Lord's unfailing love surrounds the man who trusts in Him." [Ps 32:10]
- C:** **"Your statutes are forever right; O Lord, give me understanding that I may live."** [Ps 119:144]
- P: Let us confess our transgressions unto the Lord.
- C:** **O God, You are a great and awesome God. You keep Your covenant of love even when we fail.**
- P: We have sinned and done wrong. We have broken Your covenant.
- C:** **We have not loved You with our whole heart. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are sinners. We are guilty.**

- C:** **The blood of Jesus, God's Son, purifies us from all sin.** [1 Jn 1:7]
- P: "To Him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood, and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve His God and Father--to Him be glory and power for ever and ever! [Rev. 1:5-6]
- C:** **Amen."**
