CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: From the very beginning of His ministry Jesus proclaimed, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near." [Mat 4:17]

C: **"The time has come," He said. "The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news!"** [Mark 1:15]

P: "Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord," [Acts 3:19]

C: **"Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and He relents from sending calamity."** [Joel 2:13]
