THE LORD'S PRAYER

PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: Beloved in the Lord! Let us draw near with a true heart and confess our sins unto God, our Father, beseeching Him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness. "Have mercy on me, O Lord, for I call to You all day long.

C: "Bring joy to Your servant, for to You, O Lord, I lift up my soul.

P: You are forgiving and good, O Lord, abounding in love to all who call to You.

C: Hear my prayer, O Lord; listen to my cry for mercy." [Ps 86:3-6]

P: Let us confess our sins to God our merciful Father. O God, You are a great and awesome God. You keep Your covenant of love even when we fail.

C: You are faithful even when we are faithless

P: We have sinned and done wrong. We have broken Your covenant.

C: We have not loved You with our whole heart. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.

P: We have hardened our hearts. We have indulged our sinful desires.

C: We have not been faithful to You or to one another.

P: We are sinners. Hear our confession. Have mercy on us O God.

C: Forgive our sins. Redeem us and restore us according to Your grace and mercy.

P: The Lord has heard your confession and acted on your behalf. He sent Jesus to be your Savior—to suffer and die for your sins, to be raised and to give you the victory over sin, death and the devil. By the power of the Gospel and the command of Christ I forgive you all your sins in the name of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

THE CONSECRATION

At King of Kings, we welcome at Holy Communion all baptized Christians who believe that Jesus Christ is present in this Sacrament and that forgiveness of sins is given in it. Children who have not yet been instructed to receive Holy Communion and those who are not yet baptized are invited to come forward to receive a blessing.
