CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: The hour has come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed.

C: **The night is nearly over; the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light.** [Rom 13:11-12]

P: "Come now, let us reason together," says the Lord. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow;

C: **Though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.** [Is 1:18]

P: Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion blot out my transgressions.

C: **Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.**

P: For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me.

C: **Against You, You only, have I sinned and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are proved right when You speak and justified when You judge.**

C: **Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.** [Psalm 51]

P: Almighty God, our heavenly Father has had mercy upon us. According to His great love He sent His Son Jesus to save us. As a called and ordained servant of the Church of the resurrected Lord Jesus Christ, and in His stead and according to His command, I forgive you all your sins in the Name of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.
