THE INVOCATION

P: In the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: **Amen.**

THE ADVENT CANDLE LIGHTING LITANY

P: "Worship the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs.

C: **Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name.**" [Psa 100:2, 4]

P: "Lift up your heads, O you gates; be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in.

C: **Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle.**" [Psa 24:7-10]

All *Lift up your heads, ye mighty gates! Behold the King of glory waits.*

Sing: *The King of kings is drawing near; The Savior of the world is here.
Life and salvation He doth bring; Therefore rejoice and gladly sing.
To God the Father raise your joyful songs of praise.*

P: Today we light three Advent candles: the first for faithful waiting, the second to announce the coming of the Savior.

C: **We light the third candle for sending and receiving the Good News of the Savior, Jesus, the Prince of Peace.**

P: Let us pray:

C: **Lord Jesus Christ, we implore You to hear our prayers and to lighten the darkness of our hearts by Your gracious visitation; for You live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.**

CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS

P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

C: **But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**

(silence for reflection)

P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

C: Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart: we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.

P: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of God's Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.
