CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: To You, O Lord, I lift up my soul; in You I trust, O my God. Do not let me be put to shame...

C: **Show me Your ways, O Lord, teach me Your paths; guide me in Your truth and teach me, for You are God my Savior, and my hope is in You all day long.**

P: Remember, O Lord, Your great mercy and love, for they are from of old.

C: **For the sake of Your name, O Lord, forgive my iniquity, though it is great.** [Ps 25:1-11]

P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

C: **Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name.**

P: In Christ all the fullness of God dwells in bodily form, and you have been given fullness in Christ. You have been buried with Him in baptism and raised with Him through your faith in the power of God, who raised Him from the dead. When you were dead in your sins, God made you alive with Christ. [Col 2:9-14] Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of God's Word I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

PRAYERS

P: Let us pray for the whole people of God in Christ Jesus, and for all people according to their needs. "Answer me when I call to you, O my righteous God.

C: **Give me relief from my distress; be merciful to me and hear my prayer."** [Psa 4:1]
