INVOCATION

P: In the name of the Father, and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: **Amen.**

P: "Taste and see that the Lord is good;

C: **Blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him."** [Ps 34:8]

P: "Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked...

C: **But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on His law he meditates day and night.**

P: He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season

C: **And whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.**

P: Not so the wicked!

C: **They are like chaff that the wind blows away.**

P: Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment,

C: **Nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.**

P: For the Lord watches over the way of the righteous,

C: **But the way of the wicked will perish."** [Ps 1]

CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS

P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

C: **But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**

(silence for reflection)

P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

C: **Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word and deed, by what we have done, and by what we**

have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart: we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.

P: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of God's Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.
