OFFERING

CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: Just as we bring our offerings and tithes before the Lord, let us also bring Him our sins and failures, faults and imperfections. Our help is in the name of the Lord.

C: He does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities.

P: For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him;

- P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of the Word I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.
