## **THE LORD'S PRAYER**

### **PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION**

P: Beloved in the Lord! Let us draw near with a true heart and confess our sins unto God, our Father, beseeching Him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness. Our help is in the name of the Lord.

C: **"Let us examine our ways and test them, and let us return to the Lord."** [Lam 3:40]

P: "Return, O Israel, to the Lord your God. Your sins have been your downfall! [Hos 14:1]

C: **Let us lift up our hearts and our hands to God in heaven and say: 'We have sinned and rebelled.'**" [Lam 3:42]

P: Say to Him: 'Forgive all our sins and receive us graciously.'" [Hos 14:1-2] Let us confess our sins to God our merciful Father.

**All: O almighty God, merciful Father, I, a poor, miserable sinner, confess unto You all my sins and iniquities with which I have ever offended You and justly deserved Your temporal and eternal punishment. But I am heartily sorry for them and sincerely repent of them, and I pray You of Your boundless mercy and for the sake of the holy, innocent, bitter sufferings and death of Your beloved Son, Jesus Christ, to be gracious and merciful to me, a poor, sinful being.**

P: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of God's Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ; I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

**All: Amen.**
