CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: The Bible says, "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." [1 John 1:8]

C: The Bible also says, “If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.” [1 John 1:9]

P: “Let us examine our ways and test them, and let us return to the Lord.

C: Let us lift up our hearts and our hands to God in heaven, and say: ‘We have sinned.’”
[Lam 3:40-43]

P: “The Redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who repent of their sins, declares the Lord.” [Isa 59:20]

C: “For I take no pleasure in the death of anyone, declares the Sovereign Lord. Repent and live!” [Ezek 18:32]

P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

C: Most merciful God, I confess that I am by nature sinful and unclean. I have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what I have done and by what I have left undone. I have not loved You with my whole heart; I have not loved my neighbor as myself. I justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on me. Forgive me, renew me, and lead me, so that I may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name.

P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Jesus Christ, and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. From everlasting to everlasting the Lord's love is with those who fear Him...

C: With those who keep His covenant and remember to obey His precepts... [Psa 103]

P: Let us pray for the whole people of God in Christ Jesus, and for all people according to their needs. “Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.
