**CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION**

P: "The Lord looks down from heaven on the sons of men to see if there are any who understand, any who seek God.

C: **All have turned aside, they have together become corrupt; there is no one who does good, not even one.**" [Ps 14:2-3]

- P: "Many are the woes of the wicked, but the Lord's unfailing love surrounds the man who trusts in Him." [Ps 32:10]
- C: **"Your statutes are forever right; O Lord, give me understanding that I may live."** [Ps 119:144]
- P: Let us confess our transgressions unto the Lord.
- C: **O God, You are a great and awesome God. You keep Your covenant of love even when we fail. We have sinned and done wrong. We have broken Your covenant. We have not loved You with our whole heart. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are sinners. We are guilty. Create in us pure hearts, O God. Blot out our transgressions, and for Your own sake, remember them no more. Forgive our sins. Cleanse us. Heal us and restore us according to your grace and mercy.**
- P: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of God's Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son ☩ and of the Holy Spirit.
- All: **Amen.**

## THE CONSECRATION

- P: Our Lord Jesus has given His Church a wonderful and mysterious way to receive the gifts that He has earned for us through His life, death, and resurrection. It is found in this meal of bread and wine. When we set these foods aside for this special use according to His instruction and faithfully connect the words and promises of Jesus to them, they are no longer simple bread and wine. They are the very Body and Blood of Jesus. This is a great mystery, but one that we accept as true because of what Jesus said on the night He met with His disciples for a last meal. On the night in which He was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it, and gave it to His disciples, saying:
- C: **Take and eat; this is my body, given for You. Do this for the remembrance of me.**
- P: Again, after supper, He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink, saying:
- C: **This cup is the new covenant in My blood, shed for You and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this for the remembrance of Me.**
- P: Remembering, therefore, His salutary command, His life-giving Passion and death, His glorious resurrection and ascension, and His promise to come again, we pray...
- C: **We give thanks to You, Lord God Almighty, not as we ought, but as we are able. We implore You to accept our praise and thanksgiving, and, with Your Word and Holy Spirit, to bless us.**
- P: Bless these Your own gifts of bread and wine; that we and all who share in the body and blood of Your Son may be filled with heavenly peace and joy, and, receiving the forgiveness of sin, may be sanctified in soul and body, and have our portion with all Your saints. The Peace of the Lord be with you always.

**C: And also with you. Amen.**

At King of Kings, we welcome at Holy Communion all baptized Christians who believe that Jesus Christ is present in this Sacrament and that forgiveness of sins is given in it. Children who have not yet been instructed to receive Holy Communion and those who are not yet baptized are invited to come forward to receive a blessing.
