## **PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION**

Pastor: Beloved in the Lord! Let us draw near with a true heart and confess our sins unto God, our Father, beseeching Him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness. Our help is in the name of the Lord.

**People: The Lord Jesus who died for our sins and was raised again in triumph on the third day.**

Pastor: Let us confess our sins to God our merciful Father.

**All: O almighty God, merciful Father, I, a poor, miserable sinner, confess unto You all my sins and iniquities with which I have ever offended You and justly deserved Your temporal and eternal punishment. But I am heartily sorry for them and sincerely repent of them, and I pray You of Your boundless mercy and for the sake of the holy, innocent, bitter sufferings and death of Your beloved Son, Jesus Christ, to be gracious and merciful to me, a poor, sinful being.**

Pastor: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ; I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

**All: Amen.**

## **THE APOSTLES CREED**

### **THE CONSECRATION**

Pastor: Listen carefully to the words of our Lord. Listen to His invitation, promise and command. Listen and believe the mysterious truth of Jesus when He says, "This is my body... this is my blood...for you." Because these words are given to the whole Church of Jesus Christ, and so that you may better know them yourselves, we will speak them together. On the night in which He was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread, gave thanks; broke it and gave it to His disciples, saying:

**People: "Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."**

Pastor: Again after supper, He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them saying:

**People: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this in remembrance of me."**

Pastor: Remembering His death, resurrection and ascension, we await His coming in glory. Heavenly Father, we pray, Send Your Holy Spirit into our hearts that He may preserve in us a lively faith and prepare us joyfully to trust our Savior and receive Him who comes to us in His body and blood.

**People: Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven; Give us this day our daily bread; And**

**forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; And lead us not into temptation; But deliver us from evil; For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.**

At King of Kings, we welcome at Holy Communion all baptized Christians who believe that Jesus Christ is present in this Sacrament and that forgiveness of sins is given in it. Children who have not yet been instructed to receive Holy Communion and those who are not yet baptized are invited to come forward to receive a blessing.
