## THE LORD'S PRAYER

### PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: Blessed are they whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.

**C: Blessed are they whose sin the Lord does not count against them and in whose spirit is no deceit.**

P: I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD"

**C: And You forgave the guilt of my sin.** [Psalms 32:1-2, 5]

P: Let us confess our sins in before God and His Church.

**C: Gracious Lord, I confess that I have sinned against You in thought, word and deed.**

P: I have sinned against you by what I have done and by what I have left undone.

**C: Even my best attempts to perform righteous things are like filthy rags to you.** [Isa 64:6]

P: I try to do right; but I fall into temptation. I know the difference between right and wrong and still I fail. [Rom 7]

**C: O God, I have sinned against You. I am no longer worthy to be called Your child.** [Lk 15:17]

P: I am not a saint. I am a sinner.

**C: Forgive, renew and restore me by Your grace and through the person and work of Jesus my Savior. Amen**

P: Almighty God, our gracious heavenly Father, has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light. He has rescued you from the dominion of darkness and brought you into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. [Col 1:12-14] In the stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of Father, and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Let Your priests, O Lord God, be clothed with salvation,

**C: And let Your saints rejoice in your goodness. Amen.** [2 Chron 6:41b]

P: The Peace of the Lord be with you always.

**C: And also with you. Amen.**


