CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

Pastor: The Bible says, "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is

not in us." [1 John 1:8]

People: The Bible also says, "If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us

our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." [1 John 1:9]

Pastor: "See to it, friends, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away

from the living God." [Heb 3:12]

People: The blood of Christ, who offered Himself unblemished to God, will cleanse us from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God! [Heb 9:14]

Pastor: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father. Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone.

People: We have made bad choices. We have not loved You with our whole heart:

Pastor: We have chosen to satisfy our own desires. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.

People: We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name.

Pastor: If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all—how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things? Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? [Romans 8:31-34]

People: "This is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance, that we have put our hope in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, and especially of those who believe." [1 Tim 4:9-10]

Pastor: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of the Word I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the & Son and of the Holy Spirit.

People: Amen.
