THE LORD'S PRAYER

PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION—CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- P: Christmas is the Good News that God so loved the world that He sent His Son to save us from Sin and death.
- C: We are preparing for Christmas, the celebration of the birth of our Savior.
- P: The Bible says, "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." [1 John 1:8]
- C: Not only that; but if we claim to be without sin, we will reject the Savior.
- P: The Bible also says, "If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." [1 John 1:9]
- C: We need a Savior. I need a Savior. I am a sinner and I need Jesus.
- P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father and trust in His forgiveness.
- C: Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean.
- P: We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed,
- C: By what we have done and by what we have left undone.
- P: We have not loved You with our whole heart:
- C: We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.
- P: We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment.
- C: For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us.
- P: Forgive us, renew us, and lead us;
- C: So that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name.
- P: Hear the Good News of Advent and Christmas. Almighty God in His mercy sent Jesus to be our Savior. He was born for you and He died for you. For you He rose

victoriously on the third day; and for His sake, God forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of God's Word I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

THE CONSECRATION

The Consecration concludes with...

P: The Peace of the Lord be with you always.

C: And also with you. Amen.

At King of Kings, we welcome at Holy Communion all baptized Christians who believe that Jesus Christ is present in this Sacrament and that forgiveness of sins is given in it.
