Reading Isaiah 9:2, 6-7

The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned... For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there will be no end. In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. (This was the first census that took place while Quirinius was governor of Syria.) And everyone went to his own town to register.

So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David. He went there to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him and was expecting a child. While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. #### Confession and Absolution

- C: He was born to save us from our sins. [Mt 1:21]
- P: "My soul glorifies the Lord
- C: And my spirit rejoices in God my Savior." [Lk 1:46-47]
- P: With repentant Christmas joy, let us confess our sins. Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone.
- C: We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name.
- P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to be born for you, to live for you, to be for you the way, the truth and the life. For you He died and for His sake God forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ♣ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

#### Holy Communion

- P: The Lord be with you.

- P: Lift up your hearts.
- C: We lift them up to the Lord.
- P: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
- C: It is right to give him thanks and praise.
- P: It is indeed right and salutary that we should at all times and in all places offer thanks and praise to You, O Lord, holy Father, through

Jesus Christ our Lord. In the wonder and mystery of the Word made flesh You have opened the eyes of faith to a new and radiant vision of Your glory; that, beholding the God made visible, we may be drawn to love the God whom we cannot see. And so, with the Church on earth and the hosts of heaven, we praise Your name and join their unending hymn:

The virgin bears the Infant.
With virgin honor pure!

P: On the night when he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it and gave it to the disciples saying: "Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me."

Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink saying: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this for the remembrance of me." For as often as we drink from this cup, we proclaim the Lord's death, until he comes.

- P: Therefore, gracious Father, with this bread and cup we remember the life our Lord offered for us. And, believing the witness of His birth, life, death and resurrection, we await His coming in power to share with us the great and promised feast.
- C: Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.

- P: Almighty God, send now, we pray, your Holy Spirit, the spirit of our Lord and of His Church, that we who receive the Lord's body and blood may live to the praise of your glory and receive our inheritance with all your saints in light.
