OFFERING

CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- P: Beloved in the Lord! Let us draw near with a true heart and confess our sins unto God, our Father, beseeching Him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness. Our help is in the Name of the Lord.
- C: "The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love. He will not always accuse, nor will He harbor His anger forever;
- P: He does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities
- C: For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him;
- P: As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us." [Ps 103:8-12]
- C: When we were dead in our sins, God made us alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins. [Col 2:13]
- P: Let us confess our transgressions to the Lord with confidence in His love and grace. Almighty God, We have sinned and done wrong. We have broken Your covenant.
- C: We have not loved You with our whole heart. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.
- P: We have hardened our hearts. We have indulated our sinful desires.
- C: We have not been faithful to You or to one another.
- P: We are sinners. Hear our confession. Have mercy on us O God.
- C: Forgive our sins. Heal us and restore us according to your grace and mercy.
- P: The Lord has heard your confession and acted on your behalf. By the power of the Gospel and the command of Christ I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.

PRAYERS

- P: Let us pray for the whole people of God in Christ Jesus, and for all people according to their needs. "Look to the Lord and his strength; seek His face always.
- C: Remember the wonders He has done, His miracles, and the judgments He pronounced." [Ps 105:4-5]
