THE LORD'S PRAYER

PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: The Bible says, "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." [1 John 1:8]

C: **The Bible also says, "If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."** [1 John 1:9]

P: For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed... but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. [1 Pet 1:18-19]

C: **For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.** [1 Cor 5:7b]

P: He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for your sake. Through Him you believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and glorified Him, and so your faith and hope are in God. [1 Pet 1:18-19]

C: **Amen.**

P: Let us confess our sins and our sinfulness to God our Father, and trust that He is faithful and will forgive us and help us to live as we ought.

C: **Almighty God, Maker of all things, judge of all people, we admit and confess our sinfulness.**

P: We have turned away from each other in our thinking, speaking, and doing.

C: **We have done the evil You forbid and have not done the good You demand. We do repent and are truly sorry for these our sins.**

P: Have mercy on us, kind Father, because of the blood of Your Son, the Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world.

C: **Forgive us all that is past, and with the power of the Holy Spirit move us to serve You faithfully.**

P: Set our feet upon the new path of life, and build your kingdom here through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

C: **Amen**

P: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of God's Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the

stead and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ; I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen.

THE CONSECRATION

The Consecration concludes with...

P: The Peace of the Lord be with you always.

C: And also with you. Amen.
