THE LORD'S PRAYER

PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: The Bible says, "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." [1 John 1:8]

C: The Bible also says, "If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." [1 John 1:9]

P: Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.

C: Blessed is the man whose sin the Lord does not count against him. [Ps 32:1-2]

P: Let us confess our sins to God our merciful Father. O God, You are a great and awesome God. You keep Your covenant of love even when we fail.

C: You are faithful even when we are faithless

P: We have sinned and done wrong. We have broken Your covenant.

C: We have not loved You with our whole heart. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.

P: We have hardened our hearts. We have indulged our sinful desires.

C: We have not been faithful to You or to one another.

P: We are sinners. Hear our confession. Have mercy on us O God.

C: Forgive our sins. Redeem us and restore us according to Your grace and mercy.

P: The Lord has heard your confession and acted on your behalf. He sent Jesus to be your Savior—to suffer and die for your sins, to be raised and to give you the victory over sin, death and the devil. As a called and ordained servant of Christ and by His

authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of God the Father, God the Son ☩ and God the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.
