THE LORD'S PRAYER

PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: Our Lord Jesus Christ taught us to pray, "Forgive us our sins."

C: **"This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us."** [1 John 5:14]

P: Therefore, let us approach the throne of grace, asking God to forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

C: **Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion blot out the marks against me.**

P: Wash away my guilt and cleanse me from my sin.

C: **For I know my failures and my sin is always before me.**

P: Against You, You only, have I sinned, and done what is evil in Your sight.

C: **I have lived as if God did not matter and as if I mattered most.**

P: My Lord's name I have not honored as I should;

C: **My worship and prayers have faltered.**

P: I have not let His love have its way with me, and so my love for others has failed.

C: **There are those whom I have hurt, and those whom I failed to help. My thoughts and desires are frequently corrupt and sinful.**

P: Let us pray. O Lord, graciously hear the prayers of Your people that we who justly suffer the consequences of our sin may be mercifully delivered by Your goodness to the glory of Your name; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

C: **Amen.**

P: "As a father has compassion on His children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him." [Psalms 103:8-13] Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called servant of the Word I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

THE CONSECRATION
