PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION-- CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: Jesus said, "Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak."

C: Jesus taught us to pray, "Lead us not into temptation."

P: It is written, "No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear."

C: It is also written, "When you are tempted, God will provide a way out so that you can stand up under it." [1 Cor 10:13]

A moment of silent confession

P: Let us confess our sins to God our Father. Most merciful God, we confess that we have not resisted temptation as we ought.

C: We have been weak. We have given in to our sinful desires.

P: We have failed to do the good You require.

C: We have done the evil You prohibit.

P: We are sinners.

C: Have mercy on us.

P: For Jesus' sake,

C: Forgive us.

P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

THE CONSECRATION

P: Holy, mighty and merciful Lord, heaven and earth are full of Your glory.

C: In great love You sent Jesus Your Son to us to give us the gift of salvation and lead us along the narrow way of life.

P: On the night in which He was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread, gave thanks; broke it and gave it to His disciples, saying:

C: "Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

P: Again after supper, He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them saying:

C: “This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this in remembrance of me.”

P: Remembering His death, resurrection and ascension, we await His coming in glory. Heavenly Father, we pray, Send Your Holy Spirit into our hearts that He may preserve in us a lively faith and prepare us joyfully to remember our Redeemer and receive Him who comes to us in His body and blood.

C: Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven; Give us this day our daily bread; And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; And lead us not into temptation; But deliver us from evil; For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.

At King of Kings, we welcome at Holy Communion all baptized Christians who believe that Jesus Christ is present in this Sacrament and that forgiveness of sins is given in it. Children who have not yet been instructed to receive Holy Communion and those who are not yet baptized are invited to come forward to receive a blessing.
