Course Description

The term "Theology" (the study of God) has conjured up many negative connotations. Theology is thought to be dull, stodgy, and largely incomprehensible for the lay person. It is also thought by many to have little practical relevance in a believer's life in Christ. Our course is not a usual course in Theology either "Systematic," "Biblical" " Historical," "Denominational" or "Ethical." It is rather a course wherein the believer is allowed to develop his own basic belief system based upon the scriptures as they are illuminated through comprehensive study.

The student should be aware that certain influences tend to cloud the development of his own basic belief system. We all tend to be influenced by our individual age, race, nationality, economic status, educational level, place of habitation, past experiences, prior denominational church experiences and other personal prejudices. The believer needs to attempt to set aside these particular slants and focus anew on the illumination that God has revealed to us in his Holy Bible.

General Texts

The Curriculum Committee allows the instructor to choose any one text from the following list, or a combination of several texts or other sources whether they are from the list or not. The instructor also may elect to not use any text but to rely on the Biblical Readings alone. Instructors should please keep in mind the cost to the students of the materials and their availability.

The Curriculum Committee group that constructed this syllabus recommends the following texts:

Basic Bible Doctrines: Systematic Theology for the Person in the Pew by Michael L. Gowers. Available from amazon.com for \$9.99 plus shipping. November 1999, paperback, 187 pages. This book received 5 stars (highest) by the Amazon reviewers.

Basic Christian Beliefs, David Dockery (editor). Available from amazon.com for \$5.95 plus shipping. March 2000, paperback, 112 pages. This book is too new to have been reviewed

Christian Doctrine (Revised Edition) by Shirley C. Guthrie. Available from amazon.com for \$13.97 plus shipping. July 1994 (revised edition), paperback, 434 pages. This book received four of five stars by the Amazon reviewers. Much of the material in this book is quite good but it is a very liberal view of the Reformed tradition.

Concise Theology: A Guide to Historic Christian Beliefs by J.I. Packer. Available from barnesandnoble.com for \$9.89 plus shipping. Also available from amazon.com for \$8.79 plus shipping . July 2001, Paperback, 267 pages. This book would be my personal choice for this course. The Amazon reviewers gave it four of five stars. (Four of the six

reviewers thought it was wonderful but one reviewer really panned this text, claiming there was no historic development) I read this short book and even though it was basically "Reformed" in viewpoint, I found it my first choice for a text for this course.

SCRIPTURES

The use of any standard Bible is recommended. Among such recommended scriptures are: The King James Version (KJV), The New International Version (NIV), Revised Standard Version (RSV), New King James Version (NKJV), New American Standard Bible (NASB), New Living Translation (NLT), 21st Century King James, NIV formatted, or the Amplified (AMP).

Any standard Bible search resource would be very handy, as one may wish to locate Bible references to specified topics. This can be in print or via electronic means. A good Bible Commentary would also be useful.

1001 Bible Questions Answered by William L. Pettingill and R.A. Torrey. Available from amazon.com for \$11.99 plus shipping. September 2000, hard cover, 470 pages. This book received five or five stars from the Amazon reviewers. This book though "Reformed" in Theology provides sound Biblical answers to many questions that Christians have today about their faith and beliefs.

Dr. Joseph Perry of the Curriculum Committee of the ABC/NYS Lay Study Team wrote this syllabus. The Rev. Dr. Leonard Myers and Ms. Christine Paisley supplied the overall course concept.

LESSON SCHEDULE, OBJECTIVES, ASSIGNMENTS & ACTIVITIES

The general format of the class is envisioned to be:

1. For each session the students are given a specific reading assignment from the text and from the Bible. This assignment is based on several elements of our belief system as indicated in the faculty and student guides. It may seem that the list of Biblical readings is very exhaustive. In most cases these are only one or a few more verses long. You may also wonder why some of the references are repeated or why the readings are not "sorted" by book of the

Bible. The reason is that the references are so arranged in order to cover different aspects of the topics.

If the instructor feels that it would be desirable to split up the references among the class, he may do this. But it is possible to look up (especially if done with a Bible Search program on a computer) each of the Biblical references plus read the recommended text sections for each session within the two hours of outside preparation for each hour of in-class time parameters on which our Lay Study Courses are based. If you do choose to split the assignments please split WITHIN EACH TOPIC so that each student will have read some of the verses pertaining to each belief topic. I would suggest not splitting the references in any topic that does not have at least four full lines of Biblical references.

The instructor is free to delete a few of the Biblical references as he desires BUT be careful that in your deletions you are not indicating a certain preference or bias in the exegesis of the material. You may also add other scriptures that are germane to the topic. You may also add additional topics and their relevant Bible verses.

2. The student is to take notes on both the material from the text and from the scriptures. This is to be for their benefit and reference, as it will be used later to construct their final "Journal." It is not necessary to take complete notes on each Bible verse cited as there are too many verses listed (often these are repetitive) to make that practical. It is better to summarize what the thrust of these Bible verses indicate to you about the topic.
3. The students will review in class with the instructor and other students the understandings that they have received by reading the text and more importantly the Holy Scriptures. Each student will be given the opportunity to respond as to what their impressions of the required texts and verses were about. The instructor might offer his insight at this point but the instructor's view point should not necessarily be given any more weight than the views of the students in the class. By this mutual sharing and discussion the individual students are to formulate their own well-informed beliefs related to the topics covered.
4. After the class each individual student should write out what his beliefs are at the present time on the topics discussed and studied in class. This will become the student's journal.
5. At the ninth session each student will turn into the instructor their completed journal of their beliefs based on the first eight sessions. In courses that double the time of each session this could be handed in after the eighth session. The instructor will do a brief evaluation of this Journal and return it to the student. It is expected that the student will add to their Journals the material from the ninth and tenth sessions.

General Course Objectives

The General Course Objectives are that the students will develop and articulate verbally and in writing what their current beliefs are on the various topics studied in class. Their beliefs will be based on their readings/ studies of text and scripture and on class discussions. The evaluation of the student's work in the class will be based on the student's verbal and written articulation of these beliefs. The final evaluation will be either pass or no pass.
