From Your Pastor

When I announced to the congregation in mid-July of my diagnosis of cancer, I shared the confidence and hope we all have in Christ and the knowledge of, as Paul says, "All things will work to my good." I underwent surgery on October 25 and follow with recovery for about four weeks.

Because of unavailability of fill-in pastors and since we are amid our congregational Red Letter Challenge, Hope's leadership looked at various options and decided on the following:

October 27-November 17 will be lay-led services with a video sermon of Pastor Zach Zehnder preaching the sermon. Zach is an LCMS pastor and author of the book, Red Letter Challenge.

All three services each weekend will follow the same format.

We will not celebrate Holy Communion on the weekend of November 3.

While the weekend of November 17 will be a lay-led service, it is my prayer to return that we might celebrate Holy Communion.
