## Overview of Today's Readings for Your Personal Walk of Faith

**Christ Jesus, the Living Bread from Heaven, Feeds the Children of God** – By the Gospel of *“the Christ, who is God over all, blessed forever”* (Rom. 9:5), we are *“the children of God”* (Rom. 9:8), *“not because of works but because of him who calls”* (Rom. 9:11). Therefore, *“listen diligently”* and *“hear, that your soul may live.”* By His sacrificial death in His flesh and blood, He has made *“an everlasting covenant”* for us. Since He now calls us to Himself, we come to Him *“and eat what is good, and delight ... in rich food”* (Is. 55:2–3). He has come with divine compassion to save us from sin and death and to feed us with Himself. As our Lord Jesus once took bread, *“said a blessing,”* broke the loaves *“and gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds”* (Matt. 14:18–19), He also now takes bread, blesses it by His Word to be His very body, and distributes it to His Church by the hand of His called and ordained servants. Just as *“they took up twelve baskets full of the broken pieces,”* there is more than enough for His whole Church to eat and to be satisfied (Matt. 14:20).

**Ministry 101** – Inviting friends to see Hope's Nature Classroom is a wonderful way to share the love God has for design. All ages enjoy nature. We have a beautiful setting with new plants. We'd like to thank Jill Gendron for the Sunflower and vegetable plants along with Linda Semlor for the Cup Plant. The Preschool will give Nature Classroom vegetables to the congregation as a way of giving back. Native plants will be added to incorporate science and habitat which includes a butterfly garden. A good variety of plants also invites interest from the community.

**Plant Donations** – (or monetary donations for the purchase of plants) are being accepted for Native Wisconsin Perennials: Indian grass, ferns, Spikenard, Nodding Wild Onion, Purple Prairie Clover, Wild Geranium (must be Geranium Maculatum), Prairie Phlox, Yellow Coneflower, Spiderwort, Little Bluestem, Prairie Dropseed and Black-eyed Susan. Thank you for your help in creating an educational landscape for children to enjoy, learn and see God's design. Plants are required to be identified and information on where they came from (if they are a transplant) because they are researched for toxicity to children and used to create habitats.
